

1 Confirm

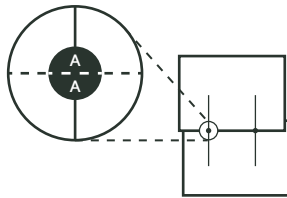
1a. To ensure that this Shoe Fit Guide is accurate, this area should be the same size as a credit card.

If not, please be sure that **Page Scaling** is turned off in your Page Setup or Printer Settings. This output must be at 100% in order to achieve an accurate measurement of your foot.

1b. As some printers still yield different results and there is a process of connecting two pages together, please double check the distance between the bottom of the size guide and the top is 35 cm as indicated by the large arrow in grey. This will ensure scale and set-up is correct.

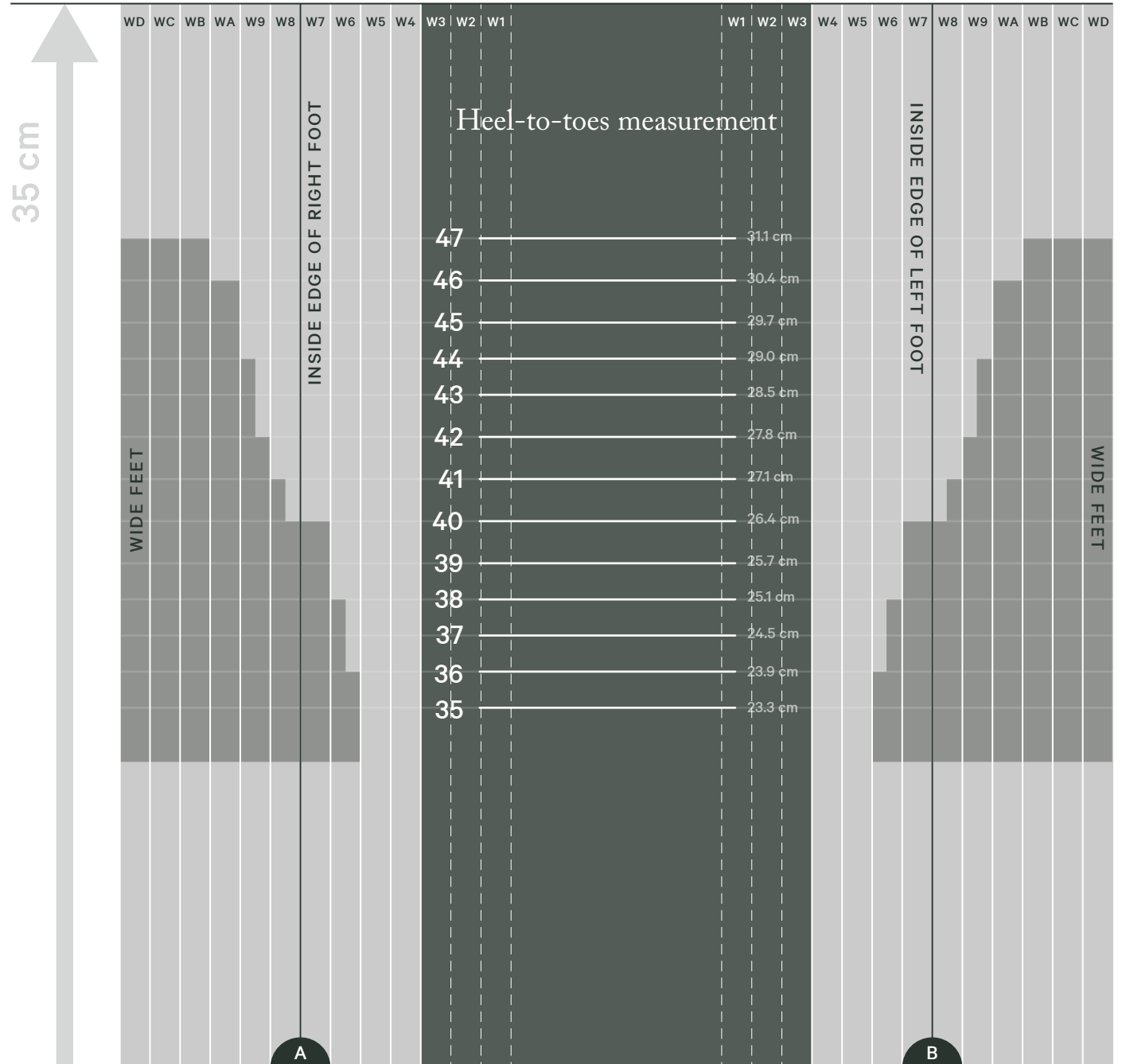
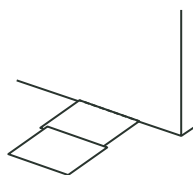
2 Align

Align the semi-circle A's and B's from Page 1 and Page 2 to form a complete circle, and the two parts of the Shoe Fit Guide align properly. Tape the sheets together.



3 Cut

Cut up along the line to form the vertical panel and place flat against a closed door.



4 Place

With your socks on, step onto measuring guide and make sure your heel is against the door. Do not place pressure against the door as this will yield a wrong indication, simply relax with the heel touching the door.



5 Length

Stand with your back against the door and have someone measure your feet and mark where your toes end. Be sure they view straight down from above the foot.

6 Width

Align the inside edge of your foot with the appropriate line. If the widest part of your foot protrudes the corresponding marker for wide feet at that size, you might need to size up. This is definitely necessary if you are near the border of two sizes.
